14. What issue did Paul say that he had raised among the Jewish leaders?
15. What further step did Felix take to get the truth of the situation?
16. In what condition was Paul allowed to live while he waited for the trial to continue?
17. Who did Felix allow to hear Paul? What was her nationality?
18. What caused Felix to tremble?
19. What did Felix hope Paul would do to obtain freedom?
20. Who replaced Felix?
21. Why did Felix leave Paul bound?
