13. Give the main points of the chief Jew's response to Paul.
14. After Paul had further explained about Jesus, what was the chief Jew's response?
15. FULLY explain the reason Paul quotes Esaias (Isaiah).
16. What was the final response of the chief Jews (vs 29)?
17. What is Paul's final condition as we end the Book of Acts?
